


Stairiser SR

The Stairiser SR is designed to run on a straight rail over a single straight flight of stairs without a middle landing (Fig 1).



Stairiser CR2

The Stairiser CR2 is designed for light-use commercial applications on a curved rail, making it suitable for a run of stairs with turns, middle landings, multiple bends or a spiral configuration (Fig 2-4). The unit folds flat against the rail when not in use, leaving unobstructed access to the staircase. The Stairiser CR2 can operate up to 180 metres.



If your staircase is too narrow, has tight turns or you require regular and frequent use of a platform stairlift throughout the day then speak to us about our Stairiser CR option.

Notes: Inclined platform lifts are intended for use by disabled persons in wheelchairs and should not be considered for mobility scooter use. Lifting platforms are generally considered unsuitable for the use of mobility scooters.

Lift configuration

- Platform folds neatly away when not in use
- Can be adjusted for right or left-hand fixing, fastened directly to the wall or supported by stanchion posts, or a combination of both
- End or side access to the platform available

Power operation

- Drive motor is powered by onboard batteries charged by a charger at each landing stop via charging contacts
- Fully automatic operation, with electronically controlled folding platform and barrier arms
- Soft start and stop for maximum comfort

Notes:

† BS EN 81-40 recommended minimum platform sizes are: 700(w) × 900(d) for class A manual wheelchair and 750(w) × 1000(d) for class B motorised wheelchair. # Part M (England and Wales) compliant. Note this product is not suitable for mobility scooter use.

Safety features

- Runs on continuously charged batteries so the platform will continue to operate in the event of a power failure (until the battery charge is depleted)
- Safety barrier arms surround and protect the user, locking down before the platform moves
- Platform automatically stops if its surfaces detect obstructions – safety barrier arms and platform can be operated manually in an emergency
- At the landings only one edge lowers so users can get on or off safely with others remaining up
- Non-slip platform floor
- Weight overload shutdown

Stairiser helps to meet the requirements of:

- BS EN 81-40 Safety rules for the construction and installation of lifts
- Part M of the Building Regulations (England and Wales), which covers the requirements that many new buildings must meet to ensure ease of access and use

- All our Stairisers are CE marked and comply with the latest Supply of Machinery (Safety) Regulations 2008 (S.I. 2008/1597)

Platform equipped with an extendable handset on a spiral cable with directional up and down, emergency stop and audible alarm buttons to allow for ergonomic seated position operation of the lift



Alternatively, joystick controls can be mounted on the top of the platform side wall



Wall mounted call stations with key switch isolation at each landing station to call and send, as well as open and close the platform



Entry and exit is simple and safe with the fold flat ramps




Glass or stainless steel backing panels available depending on site and mounting configuration. Designed to reduce potential trapping hazards
