

Legislation and Guidance

The Health and Safety (Safety Signs and Signals) Regulations 1996 require employers to provide and maintain safety signs where there is significant risk to health and safety that has not been avoided or controlled by other means (e.g. safe systems of work) provided that the use of a sign can help reduce the risk.

ISO 7010 is the International standard for safety signs.

ISO 7010 was developed to provide consistency in design across the EU. Stocksigns has incorporated the new designs and you may notice some design changes to the symbols whereas others are virtually unchanged.

The majority of British Standard symbols have been adopted by ISO and as such have now been encompassed into UK safety legislation.

Use of Symbols and Graphical Images

The use of symbols and graphical images is a simple safety system used to convey safety messages at a glance. Colours and symbols, appropriately used, provide information and warnings of hazards which are essential to personal safety.

Prohibition



A red circular band with diagonal cross bar on a white background, the symbol within the circle to be black denoting a safety sign that indicates that a certain behaviour is prohibited.

Hazard



A yellow triangle with black border and symbol within the yellow area denoting a safety sign that gives warning of a hazard.

Mandatory



A blue circle with white symbol denoting a sign that indicates that a specific course of action must be taken.

Fire Equipment



A red rectangle or square with symbol in white denoting a safety sign that indicates the location of fire fighting equipment.

Safe Condition



A green rectangle or square with symbol or text in white denoting a safety sign providing information about safe conditions.






WHAT IS LEGALLY REQUIRED?

The Health & Safety (Safety Signs and Signals) Regulations have made it a legal requirement to mark visible pipework that transports dangerous substances or preparations in the workplace with warning symbols on a coloured background.

BS1710: Identification of Pipelines and Services recommends a system of identification through the use of colour. This provides a comprehensive means of enhancing safety in the work environment.






UN Placards in Accordance with the International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code

UN substance numbering is an IMDG requirement on road and rail tanks, freight vehicles, freight wagons and containers and is displayed by either the use of diamond shaped placards 250×250 mm (minimum size) with black 65mm high numerals or an orange rectangular panel 300 x 120mm with 65mm high numerals (as in centre margin).

N.B. When the latter method is used the panel must be accompanied by the appropriate hazard diamond with class number as shown in the IMDG range on page 117.



CLP Regulation

The new European Regulation on Classification, Labelling and Packaging of Substances and Mixtures (EC1272/2008), known as the CLP Regulation, came into force in January 2009.

There is a two stage transition process with substances being re-labelled by 1st December 2010, and mixtures being re-labelled by 1st June 2015.
