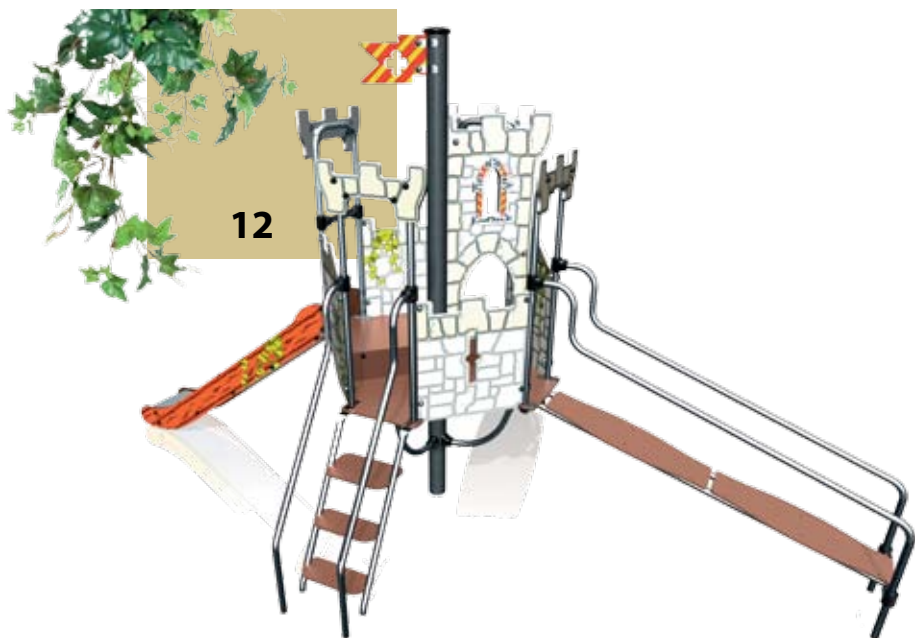

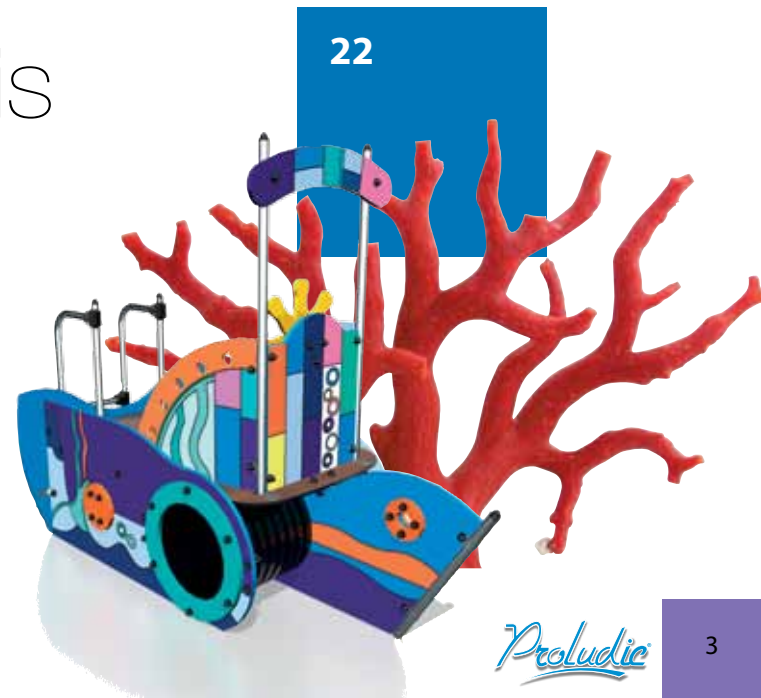

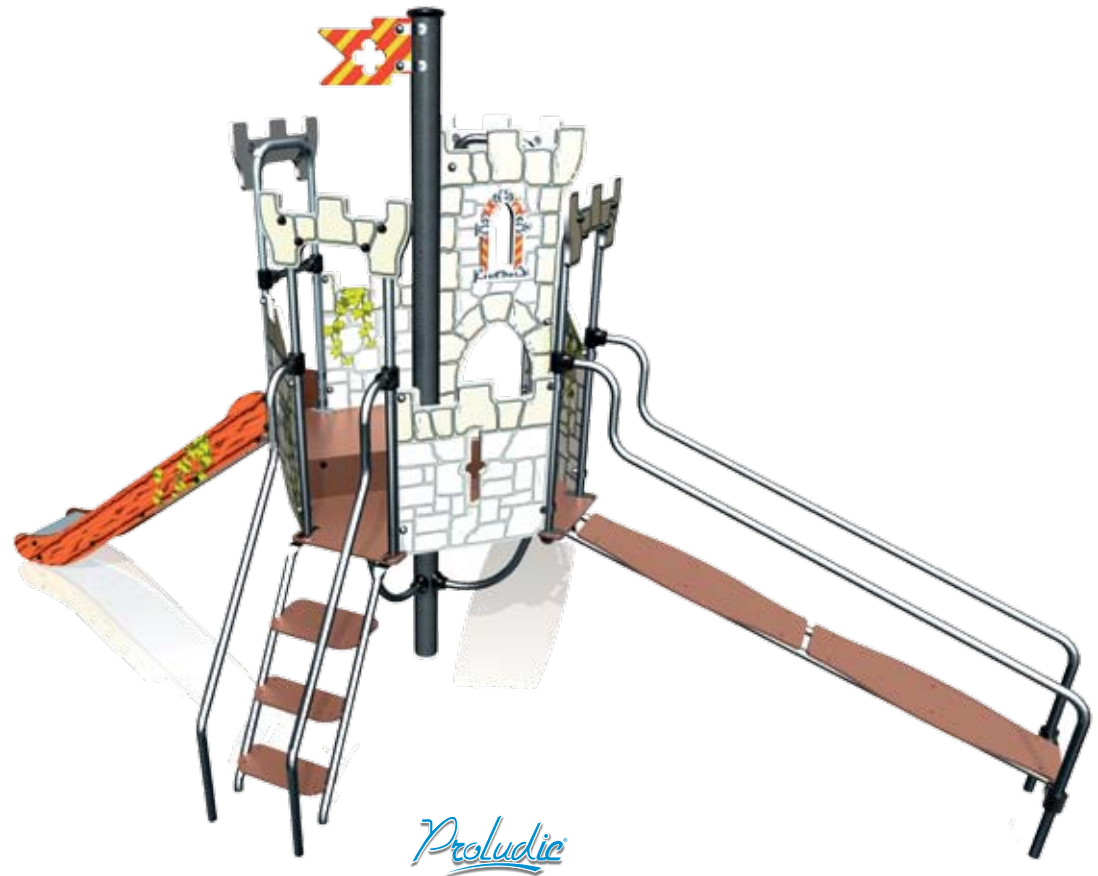

tribal symbols

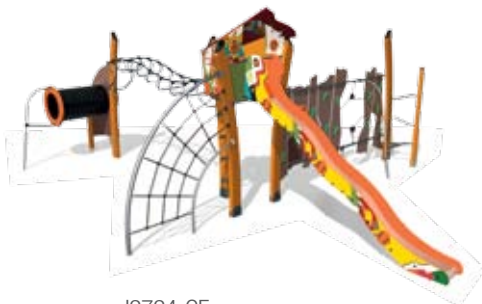
With its mix of African and Maori inspirations, the Etnik theme is based on masks, tattoos and prints.

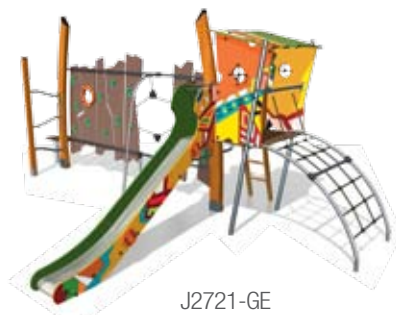
The predominant colours are those that come from the earth, with shades of brown, ochre and khaki.

depths of the ocean

This theme is an invitation to take a voyage to the depths of the ocean.

Water is present everywhere, in the form of evocative, symbolic graphics: the wavy lines in various shades of blue portray the regular rhythm of ocean waves; the circles are little bubbles of oxygen, and the unstructured patterns with their shimmering colours depict the marine algae that cover the ocean bed; a beach hut is also suggested by the decor.

Through the combination of these elements a hidden world full of life opens up before our eyes.

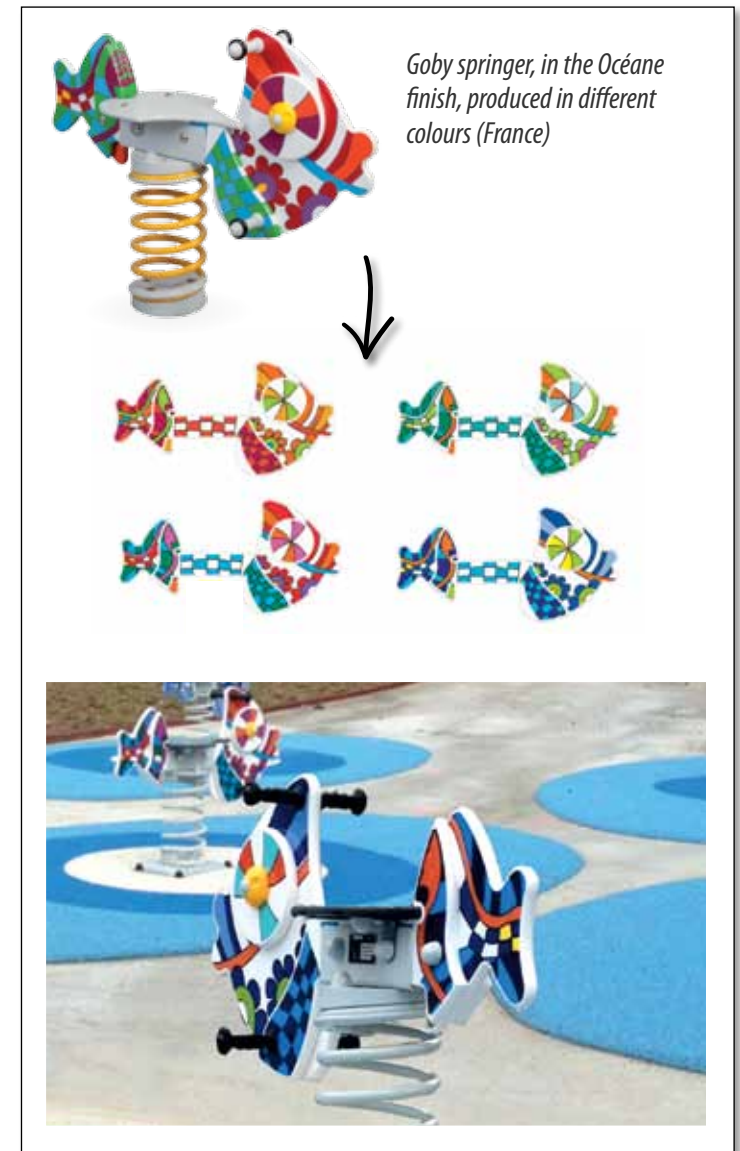

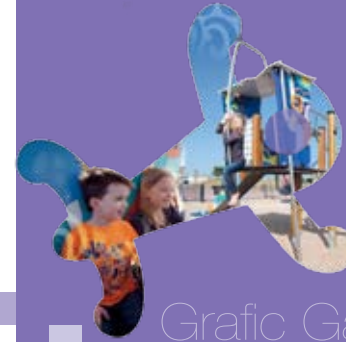
