Video Door Latch Release System

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



The Wired Video Door Latch Release System will enable you to be notified that a visitor is at your door, have a conversation with the visitor, visually identify them and unlock the door all without the need to go to the door.

You will be able to do all of this via a fixed monitor positioned at a convenient location within your property. The door will still be able to be opened manually and can be fitted onto most door or

frame materials as well as being able to release a variety of styles of locks or alternative locking methods.

HOW TO USE THE SYSTEM

When a visitor arrives at your door you may need to establish their identity both verbally and visually before they enter your home, this system would allow you to do that without having to go to the door and check and can do that from a convenient location within the home.

Our Wired Video Door Latch Release System is able to be used with the resident, enabling them to be alerted both audibly and visually of the presence of a caller, have a conversation using the 'talk' button, and if appropriate release the door to the visitor.

The video intercom system can use multiple intercoms, up to two Visitor's Panels can be connected with 4 internal monitors. The video intercom system also provides Instant or automatic recording. When the visitor rings the doorbell or motion detection is activated, the camera will instantly capture and record a video and store it on the MicroSD card (SD card must be purchased separately).

The Wireless Video Door Latch Release System may be installed with any type of door, however if the door has a multipoint lock we may need to let in a special Long Faceplate Electric Keep to suit. The keep is released by pressing the 'unlock' button on the monitor. The lock on your door shall need to be a self-relocking lock, so that when the door closes behind a visitor, it re-secures and defaults to a locked position.



The camera can be fitted viewing straight ahead or at an angle on an angled plate to allow better visibility, the system has a 2 way speech channel so you may communicate with the visitor with ease.

Whilst this system will enable you to use all of these functions from up to 30 metres away, it is always wise to ensure that you have a key, or a key holder available, in the event of power failure or inability to utilise the handset.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If the monitor does not ring then please check that there is power to both the visitors panel and the monitor, the fuse may have blown. This would cause the system to go offline.

THE UNIT MUST BE DISCONNECTED FROM THE MAINS BEFORE THE FUSE IS REMOVED.

If your system is vandalised or tampered with in anyway, please contact us and we will replace the damaged elements of the system.

Replacement or additional monitors can be purchased at any time from Ridley Electronics Limited and connected to your current Video Door Latch Release System.

If you can no longer manage to utilise the release button on the monitor, please let us know as we can cater for other versions of the system to allow operation by other parts of the body, to enable you to continue to utilise the door release function.
